USGBC launched new LEED Safety First Credits in late 2020 as part of its Healthy Economy Strategy that addresses concerns related to the pandemic and building re-entry. Bank of America Plaza was one of the first commercial office buildings to proactively pursue these new credits and add to the existing LEED Gold certification.
