Expect food trucks, interactive art installations, pop-up performances, and family-friendly activities that keep the atmosphere lively from dusk into night. And if you like a little spectacle, the festival doesn't hold back. Large-scale performances, dance installations, and surprise pop-up acts are designed to appear throughout the district, giving the whole area a “you never know what's around the corner” kind of magic.

Oh Baby! There's a brand new reason to smile at **Fort Worth Zoo** and he's already stealing hearts with his oversized ears, wobbly steps and curious little trunk. Meet Sam Houston, the zoo's newest baby Asian elephant and officially the largest elephant calf ever born at the zoo.

Born on April 1, 2026, the 285-pound calf arrived bright and early to proud mom Bluebell and quickly became the newest star of the Elephant Springs habitat. Even though he weighed nearly as much as a grand piano at birth, Sam Houston wasted no time getting on his feet. Zoo staff shared that he was standing within six minutes and nursing within the hour, an impressive milestones for a newborn elephant.

Of course, no Texas elephant would be complete without a Texas-sized name. The Fort Worth Zoo traditionally gives its elephants Texas-themed names, and Sam Houston joins siblings and herd mates with names like Lady Bird, Brazos and Travis. Visitors are already falling in love with the playful calf as he learns how to use his trunk, explores his habitat and enjoys supervised playdates with half-sister Lady Bird. Keepers describe him as calm, curious and full of personality- basically the perfect combination for becoming the zoo's newest fan favorite!

Beyond all the cuteness, Sam Houston's birth is also an important conservation success story. Asian elephants are endangered, with fewer than 40,000 remaining in the wild, making every healthy birth an important step for the species' future. Guests visiting the zoo can catch Sam Houston making appearances at Elephant Springs during the day — though like any growing baby, nap time is still a very important part of his schedule!
