



The pass is **\$66.43** (regular price \$99.98) and covers admission to a variety of experiences. Upon purchase, pass must be redeemed within 6 months. Once pass is redeemed, it is valid for one year. You can also save 35% on the Austin/San Antonio POGO Pass through your concierge.
